



### Overview

If the Launchpad server requires a factory reset, it is best practice to make a backup copy of the Content Folder (usually <u>D:\LaunchpadContent</u> or <u>D:\Clips</u>) to an external drive, network storage or cloud provider. It is easiest to do this from within Windows, but in the event you cannot boot into Windows, there is a chance the Acronis software can create a backup image of the folder for you.

### Step 1)

Insert the USB drive into the front USB port of the LaunchPad computer
